Washington Choppers LIMITED Warranty:

Please review the terms and conditions of this Limited Warranty, and pay close attention to those associated with your responsibilities that include: warranty registration of your new Chop Bob motorcycle, proper break-in and maintenance of your motorcycle.

This Manufacturer's Limited Warranty is between Washington Choppers and you, the owner.

1. Your motorcycle is warranted against defects in workmanship for a period of 30 days.
2. Paint is warranted for a period of 3 months from peeling due to application errors
3. Frame is warranted by Kraft Tech the frame manufacturer for a period of one year from date of purchase from Kraft Tech. Un-install/Install and paint are NOT covered. Kraft Tech is NOT responsible for failure of any frame that results from misuse, modification, improper installation or used in racing.
4. Rev Tech Engine is warranted for 3 year/30,000 by Rev Tech, whichever comes first. Any engine warranty claims will be directed to Rev Tech, Custom Chrome. Make sure to fill-out and send in your warranty card to Rev Tech.
5. Rev Tech Transmission is warranted for 5 year/50,000 by Rev Tech, whichever comes first. Any engine warranty claims will be directed to Rev Tech, Custom Chrome. Make sure to fill-out and send in your warranty card to Rev Tech.
6. DNA Wheels are DOT Approved. Any wheel warranty claims will be directed to DNA Specialties.

The terms of this Manufacturer's Limited Warranty shall begin on the date the motorcycle is purchased.

Transfer of Warranty:

This Manufacturer's Limited Warranty is NOT transferable.

Parts and Labor not covered:

1. Batteries, drive belts, brake pads, lights and bulbs, ALL cables, forward controls, handlebar controls, fasteners and connectors, (included but not limited to: bolts, clips, nuts, pins and screws), filters, tires, finish and metal, exhaust discoloration, squeaks, chirps, or rattles.
2. Damage caused by exceeding manufacturer's recommended weight and /or recommended rider limits.
3. Any regular or required maintenance services described in the Owners Manual and other normal maintenance services and parts which included, but are not limited to: alignments, mechanical adjustments, shipping and handling, cleaning,

- wheel balancing, diagnostic time, test rides and environmental/hazardous waste charges, storage, taxes and freight.
4. Damage and /or breakdown resulting from collision, fall over or upset, road hazard, fire, theft, attempted theft, malicious mischief, vandalism, riot, fire, explosion, lightning, earthquake, tornado, windstorm, sand storm, volcanic eruption, civil or government commotion, rust and corrosion, hail storm, snow, extreme water or flood, rotting, punctures, natural perils or acts of God, salt, fuels, lubricants, high pressure washing, cleaners, falling objects or other causes beyond Washington Choppers control.
 5. Any damage and/or breakdown caused by negligence, lack of scheduled maintenance, improper servicing, or repairs performed by owner or non-qualified unauthorized facility, failure to maintain proper levels of lubricants, or any breakdown resulting from failure to protect vehicle from further damage when breakdown has occurred.
 6. Damage resulting from customers actions. Add-on parts, modifications of any sort, lift or lowering kits, exhaust modifications, lighting changes, oversized or under sized components of any sort.
 7. Any vehicle that does not have a valid manufacturer's VIN or titled branded as salvage, junk, rebuilt, totaled, or flood damage. Any motorcycle that the odometer mileage has been changed, altered or eliminated.
 8. Damaged to the paint by anything.
 9. Any claims if your vehicle is used for towing a trailer or another vehicle or used as a commercial units, used for rental, taxi, or shuttle, delivery, hauling, police or emergency service.
 10. Damage caused by failure to follow recommended engine break-in procedures, including exceeding RPM limitations or low RPM operation. Evidence of abuse or failure to adhere to recommended break-in procedures will void the engine and transmission and drive train warranty.

Limit of Liability

Repair or replacement of defective components are express limited of your warranty.
Un-install and re-installation of warranted components are NOT covered.

Pickup/Towing

In event of mechanical breakdown caused by defect in covered components are NOT covered and owed by the owner of the motorcycle.

Miscellaneous

1. Owner agrees that he/she will not abandon the motorcycle
2. Authorized Dealers and Service are owned and operated independently and Washington Choppers is not responsible for any parts, labor or modifications made to your motorcycle.
